ATTORNEY ADMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

ELIGIBILITY FOR CAYUGA NATION COURT BAR ADMISSION

Applicants in good standing of the Bar of the Supreme Court of the United States, or of any United States Court of Appeals, or of any District Court of the United States or a member in good standing of the highest court of any Indian Nation or State of the United States, are eligible for admission to the Bar of the Cayuga Nation Court.

PROCEDURES FOR ADMISSION

To become admitted to the Court, submit the following forms along with the fee of \$50.00 (Checks are payable to: Cayuga Nation)

1. Petition for Admission to Practice
2. Oath of Admission
3. Certificate of Good Standing. One original Certificate of Good Standing from the jurisdiction where applicant was admitted is required and must be dated within six (6) months of the date of your application.
